Notice to Exhibitors

- ◆ You are expected to clean up after your dogs, both at the test and at motels. Please help us keep these good grounds.
- ◆ Owners or handlers entering dogs in a test do so at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them or their dogs. They also agree to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club.
- ◆ Barking dogs outside the test area are to be removed from the area but should not be disciplined for barking.
- ◆ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Test Committee, be asked to leave the test site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made.
- ◆ All dogs present must be on lead or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- ◆ Dogs are not permitted to wear collars during judging. The den areas for IQ, JE, SE, and ME will be fenced for this test.
- ◆ Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in excusal from the test.
- ◆ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from the test by action of the Test Committee.
